## Walking routes to the village:

**From Crovie Viewpoint carpark:** A short but steep walk down the road into Crovie.

**From Bracoden School:** A route along a public footpath which comes out on Crovie road near the Crovie Viewpoint carpark.

**From Gardenstown:** Starting at New Ground car park in Gardenstown, cross the beach and join the footpath around the Sneuk which leads you directly into Crovie Village.

Each walking route will have a trail activity, with activity materials provided at the starting points.

## Parking

There will be limited parking available within the village carparks on the day of the event. We therefore recommend parking further away and walking to the village where possible.

A small number of accessible spaces will be reserved – please let a parking marshal know upon arrival if you need to use one of these spaces.
