The spirit of the season spreads across the entire city, with special emphasis on the Christmas Market that will once set up at the João Chagas Garden, commonly known as Cordoaria Garden.

On the other side of the street, at Largo do Amor de Perdição, there will be a 'tent' that promises lots of surprises, as well as the muchanticipated ice skating rink which, once again, will be an attraction for the whole family.

From 30 November to 6 January, Porto will be dressed to perfection to welcome this Christmas, which promises to be the happiest of our lives.
